



Travel Information for Clients

Please note that parking in the first district is expensive and difficult (actually in all of Vienna). Use a Park & Ride garages if possible (see the next page), or a hotel's parking. My office is easily reached by the subways: U1 (either stop Stephansplatz or Schwedenplatz), U3 (Stephansplatz) and U4 (Schwedenplatz). Both stops are just a 5-10 minute walk from my private practice. The trams/streetcars that stop at Schwedenplatz are: 1 & 2. The tickets for the public transportation can be purchased at the machines in the train stations, subway stations or any Tabak Trafik. This ticket does not include the "Ring Tram" which is a tourist tram and not part of the public transportation.




PsychAccess

If you do decide to drive into the city, there is one on the Ring, which is within a 5 minute walk to my office. It is 4€ an hour though.

Getting to and from the airport:

If you want an easy way to get directly from the airport to my office, there is a **bus** from the airport bus terminal. You can see it here and find the time table:

It is the first bus. The stop is Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz. It is just a five minute walk then to my office. See here:

Here is the stop on Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz at the top left:




My office is just on the other side of the pedestrian zone (blue), Rotenturmstrasse 23 (PLEASE note that the **entrance to the building is in the back, behind the pharmacy**, where you see the number 2 on the map by the arrow (Rabensteig 2).

There is another option on the next page (CAT) and there are of course taxis.

Another option to get directly to my office from the airport is the **CAT (City Airport Train)**, which runs from the airport CAT to the stop Wien Mitte, with the connection then to the U3 subway station. You get on the U3 going the direction of Ottakring and ride 2 stops to Stephansplatz.

It is also a 5 minute walk **from Stephansplatz** on Rotenturmstrasse to my office. (PLEASE note that **the entrance to the building is in the back, behind the pharmacy**, where you see the number 2 on the map by the arrow (Rabensteig 2).
